RULES OF ENTRY - MLT New Zealand Gold Guitar Awards 2021

General Information

1. The MLT New Zealand Gold Guitar Awards reserve the right to photograph, record and/or broadcast any or all of the performances at auditions or finals for publicity purposes.
2. Audition times are drawn by ballot and advised after the closing date of entries.
3. Contestants perform one song for auditions. Those reaching the finals may perform the same audition song or another of their choice.
4. The origin and sound of the song **MUST BE COUNTRY**.
5. Judging is by a panel of judges during the auditions and finals.
6. Judging is based on vocal and musical ability and stage presence. Judging differs for the Singer/Songwriter section as outlined below.
7. Strictly no alcohol or drugs allowed. Any contestant under the influence of drugs or alcohol may be disqualified. Right of admission reserved.
8. Contestants may enter once only in any one section.
9. All sections are vocal - with the exception of Instrumental.
10. No pre-programmed backing allowed. Single production instruments only.
11. Official backing bands are available for auditions and finals, except for Traditional and Open Band sections. Contestants may accompany themselves and not use the backing band. However, when using the official backing band, one additional musician may join the band or replace a band member. **NOTE: you cannot dismiss the entire band and use your own backing band.**
12. No harmonies or backing vocals are allowed in Vocal sections.
13. Groups and duets may enter in any section except Vocal Solo.
14. Ages as at 31st May 2021. Junior = 12 years and under. Intermediate = 17 years and under. All entrants in the 40 Plus must be aged over 40 years, and in the 60 Plus must be 60 years or over.
15. Gold Guitar Winners are not eligible to enter the same age group the following year.
16. The MLT New Zealand Gold Guitar Awards committee reserves the right for any section to be judged outright, to add to or delete from the programme at any time, or cancel any section if there are insufficient entries.
17. Judges have the right to recall any contestants and their decisions are final.
18. Chord charts are extremely important. Please make sure they are clearly labelled and presented. Visit our website www.goldguitars.co.nz/chord-charts to view some good examples.

Traditional

19. The official backing band is not available for this section. Please arrange your own acoustic backing.

40 Plus & 60 Plus Competitors

20. You may enter only one age group. The only exception is the Open sections.
21. 60 Plus entrants may enter the 40 Plus duet and/or 40 Plus Country Rock section.

22. 40 Plus and 60 Plus entrants in all sections are ineligible for the Senior Gold Guitar Overall Award.

Junior & Intermediate Competitors

23. You must enter your own age group sections. The only exception being where Juniors may go up to perform in the Intermediate Instrumental, NZ Song and Traditional. However a Junior is ineligible to win the Intermediate Overall or Overall Runner Up, unless accompanying an Intermediate. Juniors and Intermediates may move up to perform with a Senior/ in the Senior section. This does not apply to 40 Plus or 60 Plus sections.

Open Sections

24. Band and Vocal Group sections are open to all age groups. To be eligible for the Senior Overall Award, at least one of the band or group must be a Senior entrant.
25. The Vocal Group is comprised of three or more vocalists who must use the official backing band. Vocalists must not play instruments in this section.
26. The Band section is comprised of three or more group members who must provide their own instrumental backing. The official backing band is not available for this section.
27. New Country is an open section to all ages, including duo, groups and bands. The song performed must be a song first recorded and commercially released by any artist from the 1st January 2016. Only New Country entries with a Senior Entrant are eligible for the Senior Gold Guitar Overall Award.
28. New Country Section may be capped at 40 entries, on a first-in first-entered basis. Junior and Intermediate entrants in this section may be required to audition on Sunday.

NZ Song Competitors

29. The songs in this section **MUST BE COUNTRY SONGS** written or co-written by a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.

Singer/Songwriter Competitors

30. This section is open to all solo performers 18 years and over including 40 Plus and 60 Plus contestants.
31. The song must have been written or co-written by the person performing it.
32. The singer performing the song is the winner of the Dag Scholarship.
33. To be eligible lyrics must be submitted by email before the 15 May 2021 to info@goldguitars.co.nz
34. The winner of the Dag Scholarship must be available to travel to Australia in early July 2022.
35. 40 Plus and 60 Plus entrants in this section are not eligible for the Senior Gold Guitar Overall Award.
36. This section will be judged on song composition, commercial potential, lyrics and performance.
